



Phase 3 Best Practices

On July 1, 2020 the state of Virginia entered Phase 3 of the COVID-19 reopening plan. In this phase Christian Fellowship Church planned to begin programming for our children and students. Due to the recent decision of LCPS to delay in person school attendance, we have postponed the opening of our Sunday programming.

We will, however, begin limited attendance of week day events. Following the Virginia, SAFER AT HOME: PHASE 3 GUIDELINES for Social Gatherings the following health safety measures are in place:

COMPREHENSIVE CLEANING

CFC facility and grounds are cleaned and disinfected weekly following the stipulated Virginia government, COVID-19, Phase 3 protocol. The grounds and building are cleaned before and after events and services. Areas of high contact are also disinfected and wiped down during occupancy. The specific area of ministry where events will be held will be cleaned & disinfected before and after the event.

SIGNAGE

Signs are located throughout the facility indicating social distancing, restricted areas of occupancy, limited capacity, hand sanitizing stations, and health & safety guidelines for all occupants.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

Spaces of six feet are marked on the exterior and interior entry ways. Seating and participation for both indoor and outdoor activities has been arranged to maintain six feet social distancing. Events will not include activities involving close contact or sharing of objects or items.

MASKS

CDC recommends all people of 2 years of age and older wear a mask in public settings and when around people who don't live in your household, especially when other social distancing measures are difficult to maintain. Wearing of masks is required for all staff, volunteers and attendees who are 2 years of age or older. Wearing masks for our outdoors activities is also required with the exception of exercise or the performance of ministerial duties. The wearing of masks will not replace social distancing. If you do not have or forget your mask; we will provide one.

LIMITED CAPACITY & OCCUPANCY

Following Virginia guidelines we will limit the capacity of the number of attendees. Additionally, certain areas of the building are not open for occupancy or use, limiting exposure and contact. Please adhere to signage restricting occupancy and number of people in taped off areas and restrooms.

HAND WASHING/SANITIZATION

Restrooms are opened at limited capacity for hand washing and necessary use. Hand sanitizer as well as hand sanitizer stations are located throughout the facility. Please note that restroom use for outdoor events is limited and may be restricted to port-a-johns; hand sanitizer will be available.

NO REFRESHMENTS

CFC will not serve any food or drink to be consumed on or at the facility or grounds.

WELLNESS POLICY

Our Wellness Policy basically asks that if anyone has been sick or has had symptoms of illness within 24 hours of an event or service, please stay home. If during an event or service a child or student shows sign of illness; we will contact a parent immediately to come & get the child.

COVID-19 ATTENDANCE RESTRICTIONS

- Fever (within 24 hours), cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, muscle aches, loss of taste and or smell.
- Been in contact with anyone with COVID-19 in past 14 days.
- Under self-isolation or traveled in past 14 days.

COVID PROTOCOL

Close attention is paid to the Virginia government updates and executive orders. At any time, restrictions and guidelines may change; we will adjust accordingly and keep you informed. In the event that we become aware of Corona or other illness exposure we will do due diligence to make sure the proper and necessary notifications are made promptly and to the best of our knowledge.
